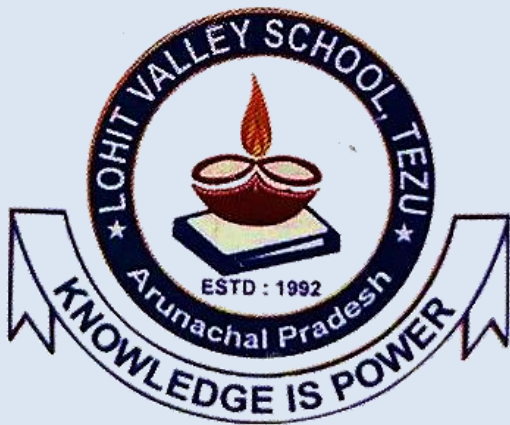

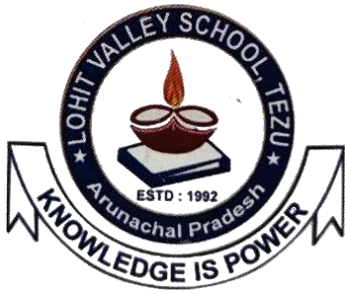

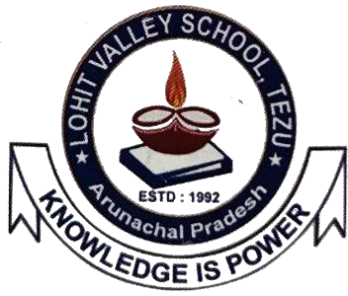

ADMISSION

Lohit Valley School, Tezu, invites applications for admission to Day School and Boarding for the Academic Session 2026–27, for classes Nursery to Class VIII. The minimum age limit for admission in Nursery is 3 (Three) years and Kindergarten (KG-I) is 4 (Four) years as on April of the particular academic session

Parents are requested to submit a duly filled admission form along with the non-refundable registration fee. Please note that registration does not guarantee admission. Selection will be strictly based on seat availability, eligibility criteria, and school norms.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED DURING ADMISSION:

1. Application Form (Duly filled in all respects)
2. Birth Certificate of the student
3. Aadhaar Card of the student
4. Passport-size Photographs of the student (2 copies)
5. Parents' / Guardian's Identity Proof (Aadhaar Card)
6. Transfer Certificate (TC) from the previous school (if applicable)
7. Report Card / Progress Report from the previous school
8. PEN (Permanent Education Number) obtained through UDISE+ from the previous school
9. Medical Fitness Certificate (Mandatory for boarder students)
10. Caste Certificate (If applicable)

SCHOOL SESSION:

SCHOOL & HOSTEL UNIFORM POLICY

Parents and guardians are requested to receive and check the school uniform and hostel uniform carefully at the counter at the time of issue. Once issued, exchange or return of uniforms will not be permitted under any circumstances.

Any alteration, stitching, or modification done by parents or guardians from their end shall be at their own responsibility.

Parents are advised to verify size, quantity, and condition of uniforms before leaving the counter.

The school management shall not be responsible for the loss or damage of students' personal belongings, including but not limited to linen, footwear, school bags, books, stationery, and other reading materials, whether belonging to boarders or day scholars.

Students are advised to take proper care of their belongings, and parents are requested to clearly label all items with the student's name and class.

In case of any loss or damage, students and parents shall be solely responsible for replacement



WHAT DO SCHOOL FEES COVER?

School fees at Lohit Valley School are not just payments—they are an investment in your child’s education, safety, and growth.

For day scholars, fees support:

- Quality teaching and academic Excellence.
- Classrooms, learning materials, and activities
- School infrastructure, utilities, and student support
- Mid-term admission is applicable; however, students admitted mid-session must pay the full fee for the academic year.

For boarders, fees include:

- Hostel accommodation
- Nutritious vegetarian and non-vegetarian meals
- Academic tuition and daily study support
- Laundry, medical care, and extracurricular activities
- 24×7 supervision, safety, and discipline

Timely fee payment helps the school run smoothly, pay staff on time, and maintain a safe, clean, and well-equipped environment.

At LVS, every rupee is used for students’ learning, comfort, and overall development—because strong foundations create strong futures.

CHANGE OF STATUS: BOARDER TO DAY SCHOLAR (EXCEPTIONAL CASE)

In exceptional circumstances, a student admitted as a Boarder may be permitted to change to a Day Scholar during the academic session, subject to the approval of the school management.

However, hostel fees already due or applicable for the ongoing term/session shall be payable in full for boarding fee, as decided by the school authority, since hostel facilities and resources are planned and reserved in advance.

Any request for change must be made in writing by the parent/guardian, and the decision of the school management shall be final and binding. No refund or adjustment of hostel fees shall be entertained except in genuine and exceptional cases.

Sibling Discount Policy

If more than one student from the same parent is enrolled in the school, a 10% discount on monthly fees shall be applicable on both academic fees and hostel fees, as per school norms.

STAFF WARDS – CONCESSION GUIDELINES

To support our dedicated staff members while ensuring fairness and sustainability, the following concession norms shall apply when a staff member has more than one ward studying at Lohit Valley School:

1. Tuition Fee Concession

Ward Order Concession on Tuition Fee:

- First Ward: 50% concession
- Second Ward: 40% concession
- Third Ward (if any): 25% concession

2. Admission Fee

- 100% waiver of Admission Fee for all staff wards
- Subject to availability of seats and approval by the School Management

3. Uniform, Books & Other Charges

No concession shall be applicable on the following items:

- School uniform
- Books and stationery
- Transport facility
- Examination and assessment fees
- Medical, mess, and personal expenses

All such charges must be borne fully by the staff member.

4. Discipline Clause

Any repeated or serious misconduct by a ward may lead to partial or complete withdrawal of the concession for the concerned student, at the discretion of the School Management.

****COMMON RULES FOR FEES & REFUND****

(Day Scholars and Boarders)

At Lohit Valley School, fee policies are framed with transparency, fairness, and smooth academic administration in mind. Parents are requested to carefully note the following rules:

1. Admission & Registration Fees

Registration and admission fees are non-refundable under any circumstances, as they cover administrative and processing costs.

2. Tuition Fees

Tuition fees once paid are not refundable, whether a student attends classes or not during the academic term.

3. Withdrawal During Session

a) Parents must submit a written notice at least three months in advance for withdrawal from school or hostel.

b) If a student is withdrawn during the academic session, no refund of fees will be applicable for the remaining period. He/She has to pay full fees then apply for transfer certificate.

4. Hostel Fees (Boarders)

Hostel and boarding fees are charged for the full term/session.

Partial stay or early withdrawal does not entitle the student to any refund.

5. Clearance of Dues

Transfer Certificate (TC), Progress Report, or School Leaving Certificate will be issued only after all dues are fully cleared.

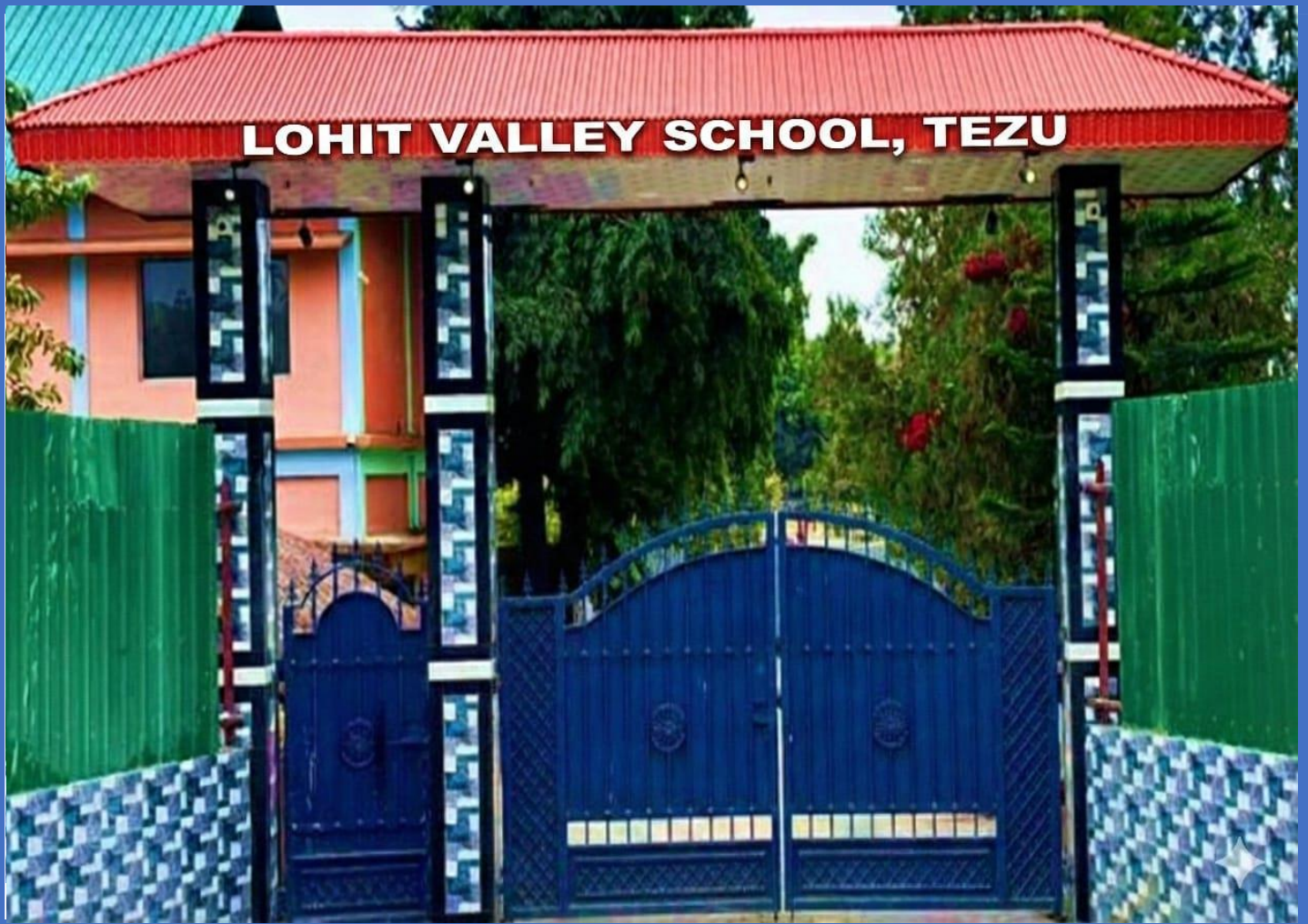
